1. **1st Annual Write-A-Greeting-Card Scholarship Contest.** Final submissions are due on April 30. The young winner of this scholarship receives an all expenses paid marine-based educational adventure to the Caribbean sponsored by SailCaribbean.com. (Ages 14-18, see rules for details)
2. **3rd Annual Create-A-Greeting-Card \$10,000 Scholarship Contest.** The contest has already begun. Students can submit original artwork, drawings, and photographs for the opportunity to have their design made into a real greeting card....and \$10,000 goes a long way towards ANY tuition!
